Messiah University Athletic Field Snow Removal Policy and Procedure September 2024

Policy: The Grounds Department is solely responsible for the maintenance, repair and snow removal to our synthetic and natural grass fields. This policy is meant to protect these playing surfaces from damage by untrained or unauthorized individuals. Under no circumstances are individuals outside of the grounds department permitted to attempt to work on or remove snow from the athletic fields.

The grounds crew have been trained by manufacturers and licensed by state agencies to care for our athletic fields. The Grounds Manager and the Director of Buildings and Grounds will manage these operations to protect the playing surfaces.

Objectives:

A. To maintain premium athletic fields safe for student athletes to use.

B. To remove snow/ice without damaging synthetic surfaces.

C. To clear the synthetic fields of snow/ice as soon as campus snow operations permits.

Equipment:

John Deere 3720 with modified snow plow Irskine 825RM PTO-Driven Snow Blower Pro Tech SP06T Turf Snow Pusher Attachment

Procedure:

<u>Step</u> <u>Action</u>

- 1 Campus must be cleared of snow /ice before staff are moved to athletic fields.
- 2 The Pro Tech Turf Snow Pusher attachment will be used on the John Deere 3720.
- 3 Push the snow to the side and ends of the field.
- 4 Use snow throwers to remove accumulating piles from field.
- 5 Apply ice melt products only as a last resort.

Snow will only be removed from Anderson Field when absolutely necessary.
